



E.F.C.S. Emergency Fire Containment System User Instructions

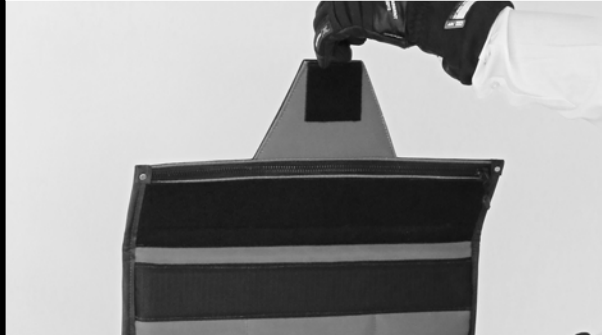
- 1** Remove the (E.F.C.S.) from the Storage Container.



- 2** Remove the provided Thermal-Guard gloves from the E.F.C.S. pocket & install.



- 3** Grasp the lower loop on the upper leather flap & lift to expose zipper, open the zipper.



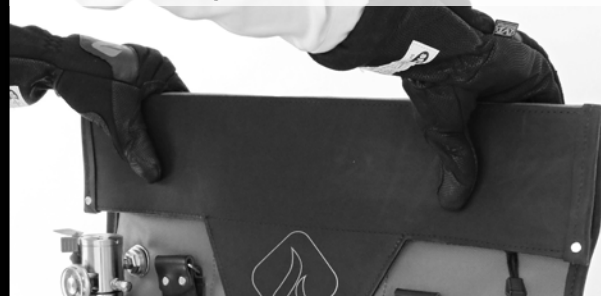
- 4** Place the fire threat inside of the E.F.C.S. place the battery end of the device (if known) at the bottom of the E.F.C.S.



- 5** Zip the E.F.C.S. closed (if the zipper fails to close, immediately proceed to step #6)



- 6** Fold the upper leather flap to the closed position & firmly mate the hook and loop Velcro together to ensure a proper seal.



- 7** Arm the suppression system by turn the arming lever counter-clockwise until the red indicator button on the actuator top is visible. Relocate the E.F.C.S. to a designated "safe area" for best results position the E.F.C.S. in the upright position.

Warning failure to follow these warnings could create a risk of serious injury.

- **SEVERE BURNS OR DEATH** - Ensure the provided fire resistant gloves are correctly installed and any other optional personal safety equipment prior to deploying the E.F.C.S.
- **Note:** Never attempt to pick up any item which is fully engulfed in flames. Extinguish all fires in accordance with relevant aviation regulatory procedures prior to inserting in the E.F.C.S.
- **SMOKE INHALATION** - Ensure the E.F.C.S. upper sealing flap is correctly closed and sealed to contain the maximum amount of smoke from escaping the system.

NOTICE

- **PROCEDURES** - strictly Adhere to specific aircraft operating procedures for fire on board aircraft.
- **PROJECTILE** - To reduce the possibility of the storage container or E.F.C.S. becoming a projectile, the system must be stowed during taxi, takeoff, landings and turbulence.
- **SKIN IRRITANT** - the E.F.C.S. exterior material contains fiberglass and may be irritating to the skin with excessive exposure.
